

The following criteria are those that will be considered in the selection of all new and experienced Induction Mentors. Of particular importance in the selection are those skills and experiences related to assisting other teachers, promoting success and the ability to work well with students and fellow employees.

#### **Minimum Qualifications**

- A. Possess a valid Clear California Teaching Credential with at least three years of effective teaching experience or successful completion of an Induction program.
- B. Demonstrates exemplary teaching ability as indicated by among other things:
  - 1. Effective lesson and unit plan organization.
  - 2. Effective communication skills.
  - 3. Subject matter knowledge.
  - 4. Mastery of a range of teaching strategies necessary to meet all the needs of students.

### **District Criteria**

- A. References Each applicant is required to submit **two references** from individuals with specific knowledge of his/her expertise as follows:
  - A reference from his or her current principal or evaluator.
  - A reference from another individual who has knowledge of his/her teaching skills, relationship with colleagues and leadership skills.

### B. Curriculum and Instructional Skills

- The applicant serves a role model to students, teachers, parents, and the community.

- 3. Curricular design integrates effective teaching strategies and methods including technology integration.

- 2. Forms positive professional relationships
- 3. Engages in non-evaluative and unbiased analytical and reflective conversations
